#### My context on e-science and art


- My first training is as a physicist and astronomer

- Champions writing by artists and designers about their own work.




# Why this astronomer and a human is unhappy today

- We are very badly designed to understand the universe
  - Our senses were developed to allow us to survive on earthfind food, procreate- but not to understand the world
- We have change our cultures quickly
  - In face of population growth, continuing wars
  - In face of pollution and destruction of the ecology we are tuned to
  - In face of climate change
  - In the past when societies faced such situation, they moved
  - We have no where to move to...we must change our selves and our cultures



- The key problems we are working with are very complex, and we must adapt quickly
- My parents after world war II helped set up UNESCO in 1947
  - Hoped the UN, WHO and other transnational organisations could change the world to prevent war, and spread well being
- Reluctantly I think we have failed to implement their vision
- Perhaps the age of the individual genius is over
- We need to start the age of the team genius
- And for this we need new ways of creating transdisciplinary collaborations.
- We need to change our culture not just invent things.
- don't think we know how to do this, I don't...
- With projects like the Human Project in Santa Luzia we try ??



## My Career in Science


- Astrophysics

- 1992: Historian Daniel Boorstin:


150 years ago:
