
**STUDY & DESIGN YOUR PROJECTS AROUND OUR FOUR THEMES:**


- 1 Transnationalisms, Migration, & Displacement**  
 Courses in this area illuminate the dynamic social cartographies of the Americas by focusing on cross-border demographic, cultural, social, economic, and political flows linking Latin American and Latino communities.
- 2 Intersectionality, Identities, & Inequalities**  
 This theme highlights the interconnected dimensions of identity categories, such as race, ethnicity, nationality, socioeconomic status, gender, sexuality, ability, and age, and the social structures that rely on and reproduce these categories and inequalities.
- 3 Collective Action, Social Movements, & Social Change**  
 Courses explore how communities come together to influence political, cultural, economic, and social structures and institutions, with a focus on grassroots activities, political/civic engagement, and social change projects at local, national, regional, and inter- and transnational levels.
- 4 Culture, Power, & Knowledge**  
 This theme emphasizes the analysis of contested symbols, meanings, aesthetics, and representations; interrogates relations of power, definitions of culture, markers of difference, and the construction of knowledge claims; and connects theoretical approaches to broader social, political, historical, and contemporary transformations.


